Love to be... was established in 1994 at the Music Factory in Sheffield and is known for being one of the original Super Club brands which contributed to shaping modern day dance music culture. Love to be... quickly established itself as a leading brand within club land by winning Mixmag club night of the year in 1996 in which year their first Love to be... Album was released. Love to be... has invited the world's top DJs to grace their decks including Pete Tong, Roger Sanchez, Eric Morillo and has made stars of their resident DJs. Love to be... pioneered the concept of glam clubbing to a stylish house soundtrack and has gone on to stand the test of time continuously moving with trends and culture for 3 decades and is now one of Europe's longest running events.

and has held overseas events in Ibiza (at Pacha, El Devino, Eden and Es Paradis), New York, Dallas, Sydney, Singapore, Dubai and Amsterdam to name a few. In recent summers Love to be... has returned to Ibiza for a series of parties in San Antonio with Pukka up boat parties and at the legendary Space with Carl Cox.

The official Love to be... History of house Sheffield event in 2016 at Magna pulled in a staggering 5000 people and the past 2 years has seen the team hold sell out events around the U.K

Over the years Love to be... has spread its gospel via tours up and down the UK from the Ministry in London to Mint club in Leeds and Sankeys in Manchester,

Love to be... Sheffield's finest... The finest Northern superclub... The story so far... Read on...

The 1994 closure of the Palais night club left the Sheffield clubbing party faithful with little to smile about. I mean Sheffield's pretty grim anyway, but with no bloody clubs to go to it was time to pack your suitcase and head for the hills. Well at least that's what Marc Black, Tony Gedge and Tony Walker thought. The Leeds based Music Factory (then home to Up Yer Ronson and Back 2 Basics) bought the venue, refurbished it and handed the newly cut keys over to the aforementioned trio. That was the beginning of Love to be...

The opening night on May 14th was a roadblock. Outside, queues stretched in two directions right round the club. Inside, queues stretched in two directions right round the toilets. From here the club's reputation grew & grew. Clubbers from all over the country flocked to the new sensation. Months later they continued to flock even though it wasn't new anymore. Within a year Love to be... was a national clubbing institution and by 1996 was, according to Mixmag, 'on a par with the likes of Cream'.

Not wanting to deprive the rest of the country of the Love to be... good time vibe, the crew decided to don their driving gloves and hit the road. Their Grolsch backed 22 date club tour took them from Edinburgh to Bournemouth to Greece to Ibiza and then back home again. Those Love to be...ers have such a hard life.

With no more club orientated avenues left to explore Tony and Marc decided the time was right for a record label. The imaginatively named Love to be... Labelled was launched in November 1995. Enlisting big names like Tony Humphries, Tom Wainwright and DJ Disciple the label got off to a flying start. Tracks such as 'Crazy' and 'Spin That Wheel' (featured on CD 2 by Tony Walker) provided a perfect soundtrack for the club. 1996 saw Tony Gedge leave Love to be... to concentrate on the label, leaving Marc with total control of the club.

The hugely successful second birthday on May 11th '96 showed that the Love to be... punters were still mad for it, and it was then that Marc decided to give his loyal crowd something back


